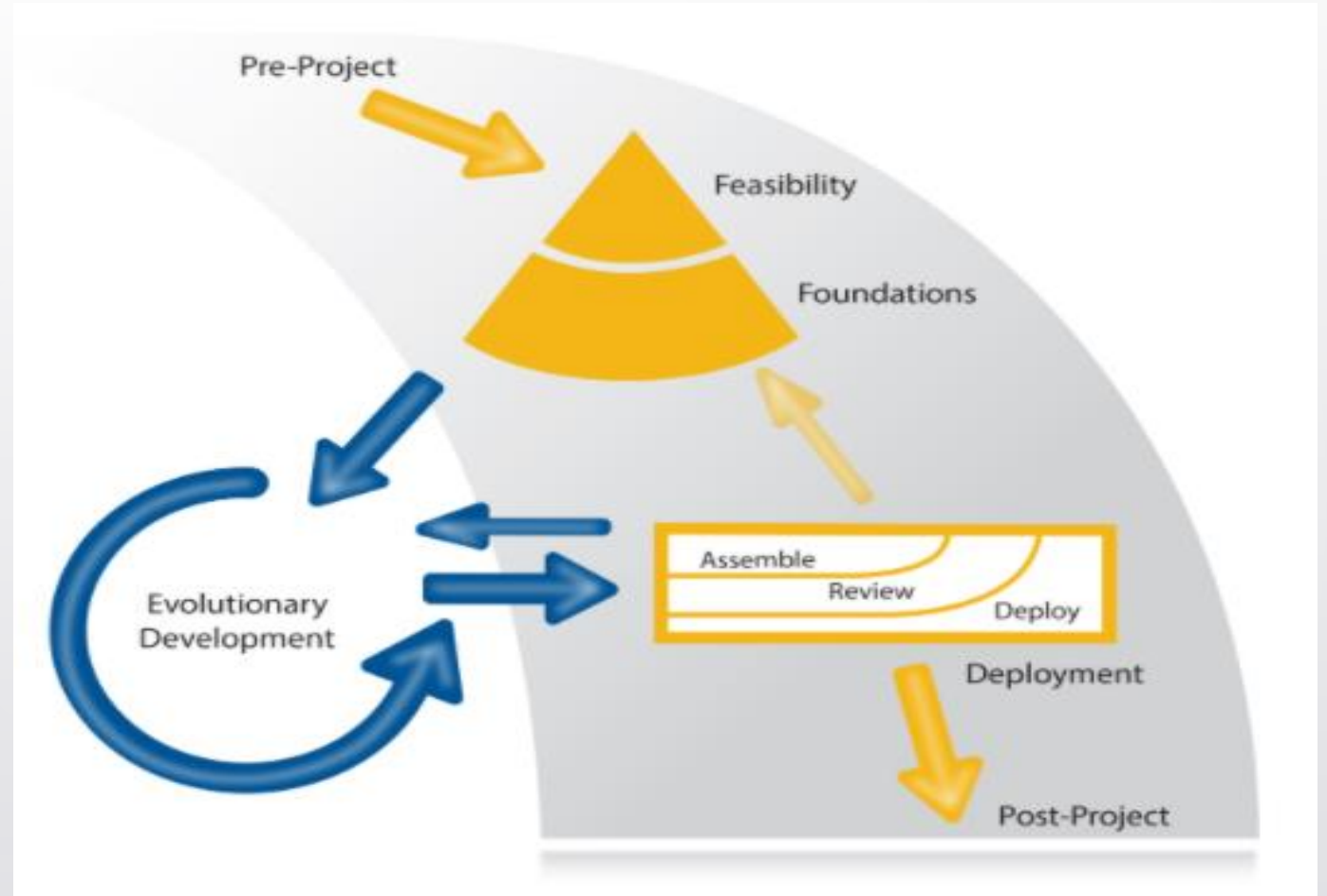

DSDM Phases

- Pre-Project Phase
- Foundation Phase
- Deployment Phase
 - Assemble
 - Review
 - Deploy
 - Closing the Project
- Feasibility Phase
- Evolutionary Development Phase
- Post-Project Phase

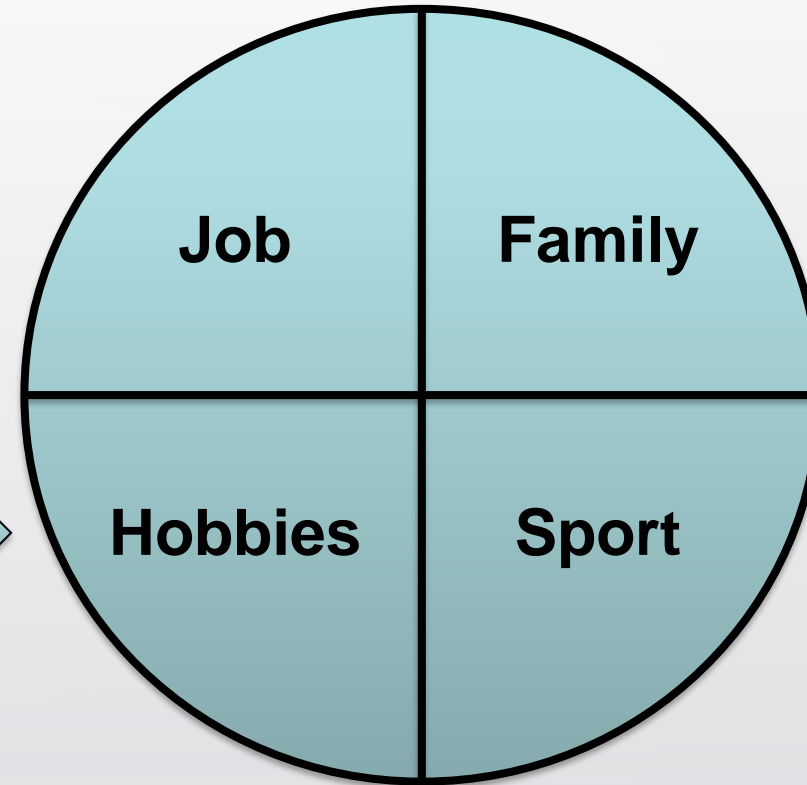
- You are now going to be put into groups.

DSDM Agile Teams

Agile teams are:

- Self-directed
- Small
- Composed of users and developers with equal responsibility
- Subject to re-structuring if team is not working
- Underpinned by a team success approach/no blame culture

Project Team:

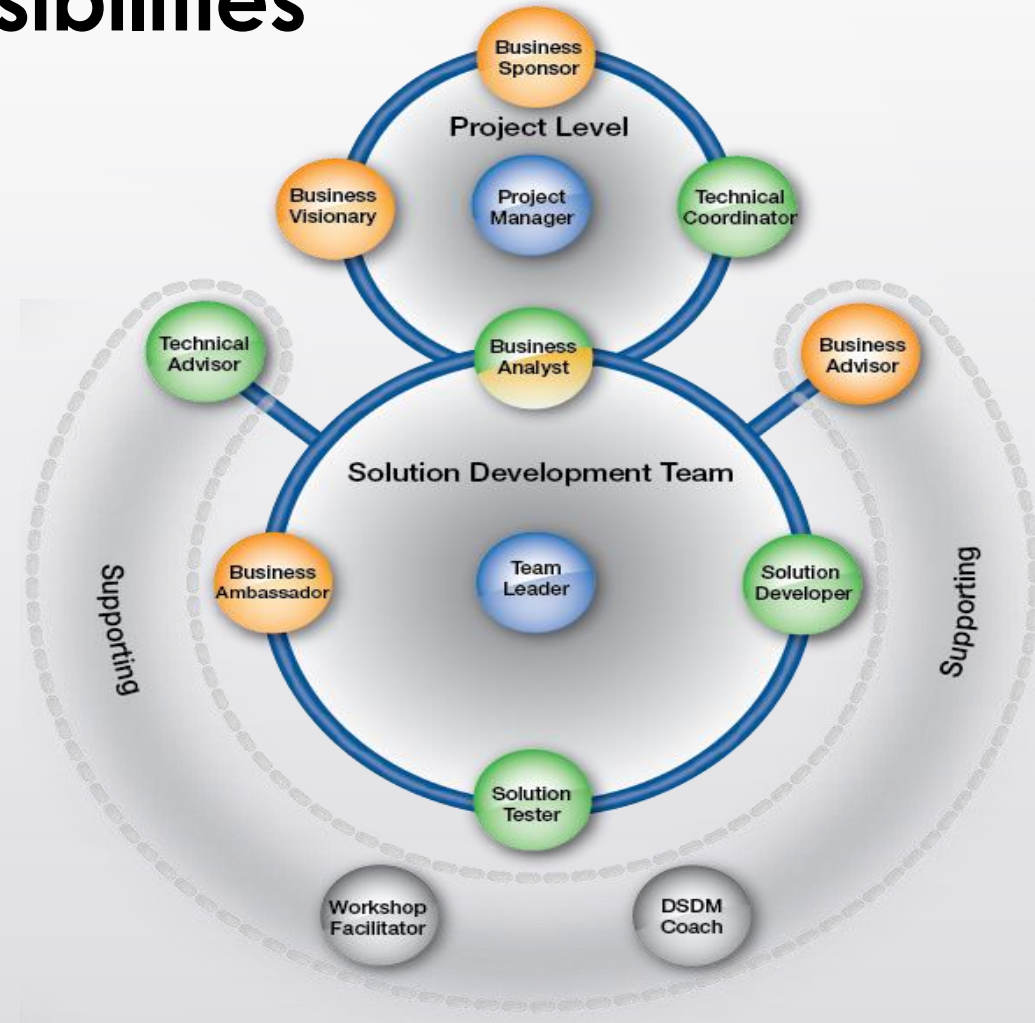
- Project Manager
- Business Sponsor
- Technical Co-Ordinator
- Business Visionary
- Team Leader

Solution Development Team:

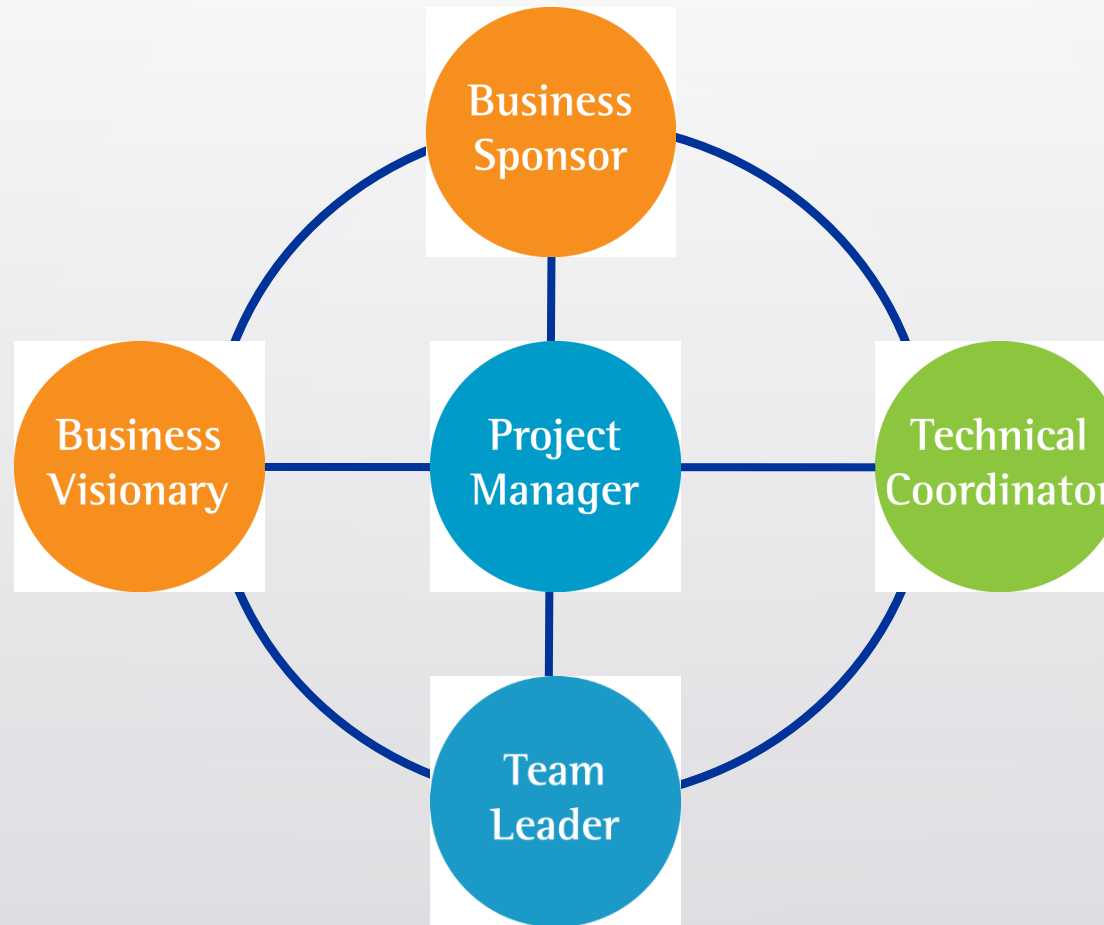
- Business Ambassador
- Solution Developer
- Business Analyst
- Solution Tester

Supporting Team:

- Business Advisor
- Workshop Facilitator



Project-level Roles

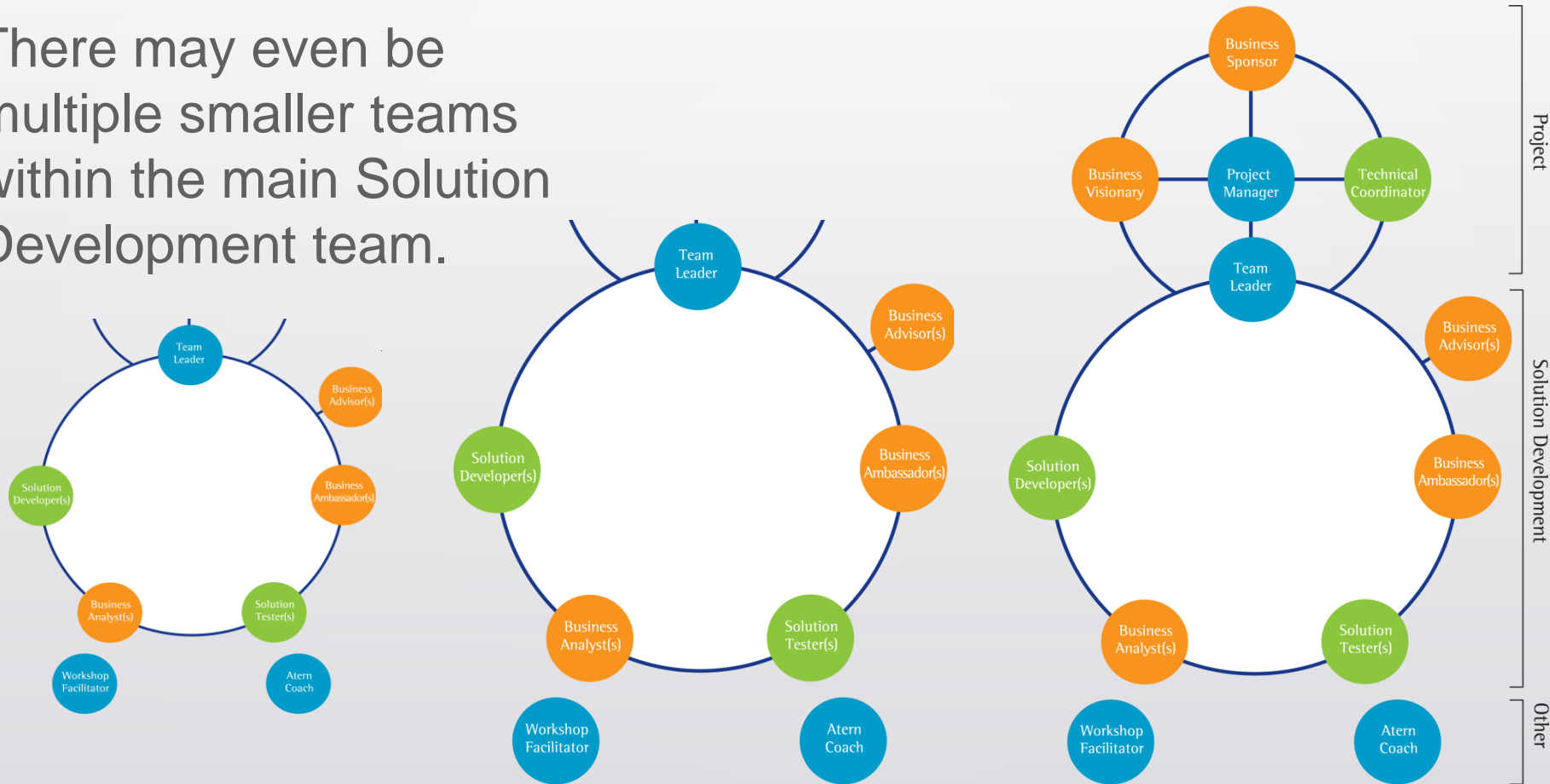


Solution Development Team Roles



Multiple Teams

There may even be multiple smaller teams within the main Solution Development team.





Supporting or Specialist Roles

Specialists may be brought in as required, including but not restricted to:

- Business consultants
- Technical consultants
- Specialist in human factors
- Configuration manager
- Quality manager
- Systems integrator
- Operations coordinator
- Support and maintenance specialists
